

Happy Families Game Rules



You need at least 3 players.

1. The cards are thoroughly shuffled and dealt out to the players one at a time clockwise.

Some players will have one more card than others, but this does not matter.



2. The player to dealer's left begins by asking any other player for a specific card:

"Michael, do you have the card that says Jackie Robinson was the first African-American player in the Major Baseball League? It is A1"

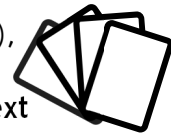
3. The player asking for a card must already hold at least one card of the same Happy Family.

If the player who is asked has the requested card, it must be given to the player who asked, who can then ask the same or another player for another card.

4. If the player who is asked does not have the requested card, then the turn passed to that player, who now asks any player for a card.

5. Whenever a player collects a Happy Family (four cards of the same set), these are placed face up on the table.

If this leaves the player without cards, the turn to ask passes to the next player to the left.



6. The winner is the player who has most Happy Families when all the cards have been laid down.
